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SYLLABLES

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SYLLABLES**IMPORTANT RULE**

A vowel standing alone says its name.

a, e, i, o, u

Sometimes
y can say i or e

SYLLABLE TYPES**CLOSED SYLLABLE****Short Vowel Sound**

A consonant follows the vowel and closes off the sound and makes the vowel sound short.

V-E SYLLABLE

The vowel is closed off but the e that follows makes the vowel say its name again. When the vowel says its name it is a long vowel. After the e gives its sound away it is silent ɛ.

OPEN SYLLABLE

When the vowel is not followed by a consonant in the syllable the vowel has a long sound and the vowel says its name.

Like: ā, gō, rē, rō, prō
